Friday, November 16th, Celebrate Laksmi, Goddess of Prosperity and Abundance, with our annual Money Pouring ritual. **Tuesday, January 22nd, Celebrate Nike**, Greek Goddess of Victory. Full Moon in Leo.

Tuesday, November 27th, Celebrate Sappho and The Muses. A night of singing, dancing and poetry. Waning Moon in Cancer. **Thursday, February 21st, Full Moon in Virgo Total Lunar Eclipse, Celebrate Ma'at**, Goddess of Truth, Justice and Order.

Tuesday, December 11th, Celebrate Tonantzin/Guadalupe, Goddess of Love, Compassion and Mercy. Moon in Capricorn. **Tuesday, March 18th, Celebrate the Spring Equinox and Vila**, Shape-Shifting Eastern European Goddess.

Friday, December 21st, Celebrate Winter Solstice and Sophia, Goddess of Wisdom. Sun in Capricorn, Moon in Gemini. **Monday, April 7th, Celebrate Haumea/Papa**, Hawaiian Earth Mother, with a Money Pouring ritual. Waxing Moon in Taurus.



THE DEDICANT SERIES is for womyn who are Kokua or Witch School Sisters, and/or Temple Dedicants. This series is for womyn who wish a deeper ritual practice with Sisters who have experience with the ritual structure and traditions of our Temple. **Full sign-up in the Open Series is required; you must sign up for the entire Dedicant Series to participate.** Please see below for exchange information.

Thursday, February 7th, , Dedication ritual and Honoring of Brigit. Dedicate to our Temple for a year and a day. New Moon in Aquarius. **Monday, April 21st, Celebrate Selket**, Egyptian Scorpion Goddess. Full Moon in Scorpio.

Friday, March 7th, Celebrate Sedna, Inuit Goddess of the Ocean. New Moon in Pisces.



THE DEEPENING SERIES is for womyn who are core members of Daughters of the Goddess, who are dedicated to the work of promoting the mission of the Temple, and who have the Temple as a primary focus in their lives. This series is for womyn who desire to be a part of sustaining the Temple, working magick for this purpose as well as to meet our own personal needs. We create an in-depth experience with the technique and magick of ritual in conjunction with the Open Series. **Attendance in the Open Series, participation in Kokua, and prior circling with Daughters of the Goddess for at least one year is required.** You must sign up for the entire series to participate; this group is limited to 13 womyn.
