*"The starting point for a better world is the belief that it is possible." – Margaret Mead*


We are grateful for the vision of peace that is unfolding. Within two days in February between eight & 11.5 million people marched worldwide for peace, transcending class, age,

## BEHIND THE SCENES

### *Lupa*

Around '84 I attended a talk by Marion Zimmer Bradley. At the end, she gave us a phone number to call if we were interested in a womyn's circle. That was Diana Paxson's number; I attended my first Dark Moon Circle and I'm still there. A certain type of magik and bonding on the astral occurs when you work within a closed circle for nearly 20 years.

I was swept into the Goddess' ways via DarkMoon Circle, which birthed The Fellowship of The Spiral Path (a Pagan church) and consecrated me as a Priestess in '89. Then She led me to ZBudapest. I took classes and worked on various Spiral Dances at the Women's Building and the *Goddess Is Alive* conferences. Later She swept me over to Teish, Monica Sjoo, Merlin Stone, Nicky Scully, Marija Gimbutas... and to Diane di Prima who was then teaching at the now defunct SF Institute of Magikal and Healing Arts. My training with Diane and the other institute teachers catapulted me deeply into my healing work. (And gave me enough Crowley to know that the Beast was not my cup of tea!) The classes were small and frequent which, for me, instilled a much stronger connection to the healing channels. We were taught meditations to do before opening to healing energies, which I still use today. Combining Reiki attunements and the Goddess intention of Perfect Love and Perfect Trust is my inspiration for leading many healing circles and rituals, on the mundane and astral planes (distant healing). [Note: Look for a Healing Circle Bud coming to DG sometime in the future.]

Although I continued to circle with DarkMoon and held an open Full Moon Meditation every month at my home, I still wanted MORE! After one of the Spiral Dances in Orinda, I began attending DG circles. There was so much wild maiden, crone and amazon energy present! I wondered, will I be able to keep up with these womyn? Gradually, I found that DG easily ebbs and flows with womyn's cycles and desires. I began putting more of my energy into DG by working with Kokua, our volunteer team, being a Guardian, assisting Leilani with ritual crafting, co-facilitating rituals and creating a DG Astral Temple. My Priestess path has led me to DG, a magikal community of amazonian womyn. I feel fortunate to have you all in my life and look forward to continually co-creating the ever-widening circle that is DG!

Checking for fever whenever we were sick.


I remember my Grandmother's hands folded on a


